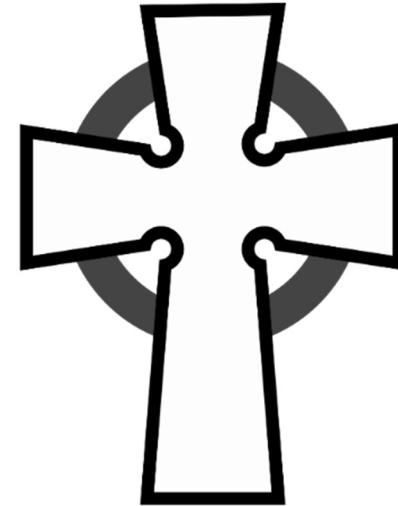

Canadian Foodgrains Bank Kenya Learning Tour - Rebekah Sears Today – both services

Early this year, Rebekah Sears, from our church, travelled to Kenya on a Learning Tour with Canadian Foodgrains Bank.

CFB is a partnership of 15 churches and church-based agencies (including Alongside Hope), working together to end global hunger.

Through their members, CFB responds to both humanitarian crises and long-term development needs, plus speaks to the government about these issues.

On this trip, the group visited three regions of Kenya, connecting with local partners of Alongside Hope, Canadian Baptist Ministries and Mennonite Central Committee.

Today, she will be sharing with the congregation about what she learned on the trip, particularly focusing on her time with Church World Service Kenya, which is a local partner of Alongside Hope.
