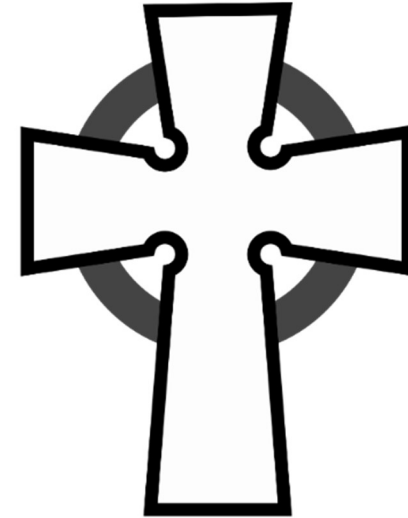

Congregational Meeting on the future of the Stone Church Feedback

Vestry was pleased that so many people chose to participate in the congregational meeting held last Sunday after the 10:30 service. Thank you for listening to our presentation and for your good questions and comments afterwards.

There were 47 people who signed the attendance sheet, which included the two wardens and seven vestry members. Since vestry was unanimous in their support of both matters, we have excluded them from the results.

We received 33 feedback sheets from parishioners, with the following results:

- Do you support vestry in pursuing the sale of the Stone Church for \$1.00 to the Orthodox Church?

33 responded with yes; 1 responded with no

- Do you support vestry in modifying the parameters of the Stone Church Trust Fund and using the funds for needed repairs to the Stone Church?

19 responded with yes; 14 responded with no

Thank you for your continued prayers that the Lord will guide vestry in this process to the end that the Stone Church may once again be used as a place of worship.
